**WISDOM FOR THE WEEK:**

**Last week I sent all of you my prespective on Halloween in response to President Cordy's question about why kids should not wear Halloween masks. I recieved back a reply from my frined Jon Barr. He and I have been discussing the principle of being able to commit sin after your are saved. My question to him was how a Christian could justify committing sin after they were saved just because they believe they will go to heaven anyway. He has been very helpful in presenting his prespective to me as a Christian Minister on that subject (see [http://www.vcaa.com/epistles/being\\_saved.htm](http://www.vcaa.com/epistles/being_saved.htm)). That is what he is referring to in the following letter about "being able to do 'anything' after they are 'saved'". I would commend his reply to you and anyone who is a Christian and wondering what the Savior would have us do in our lives regarding Halloween.**

**Here is his letter to me (reprinted with his permission):**

**Cordell,**

**A personal perspective on halloween:**

**The idea of Christians celebrating a pagan holy day takes me back to a discussion we had about Christians being able to do "anything" after they are "saved." A person who knows Christ as his Savior, who allows the Bible to guide his life, who really is "born again," who is following Christ, should not observe a satanist high holy day.**

**I have seen many areas of the country celebrate halloween and must say that many people take this celebration seriously. In one area, one dares not go out on halloween because of the mischief which no doubt will come. I have personally spoken with individuals who of necessity would carry a chain saw in their vehicle so they could cut the fallen trees out of the roadway in order to get home on halloween or the day after. In another area up to 50 percent of the homes were gruesomely decorated well before October 31. Not a one had any "Christian" symbols.**

**Halloween is not a celebration for Christian involvement. One might say, "There is nothing wrong with children dressing up like GOOD characters on halloween." However, whatever the costume, that person is still celebrating a wicked holiday.**

**I would encourage all to examine the roots of this pagan celebration.**

**The Scriptures say:**

**Eph. 5:11-12 And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them. (12) For it is a shame even to speak of those things which are done of them in secret.**

**Pr 4:14 Enter not into the path of the wicked, and go not in the way of evil men.**

**1Co 10:20 But I say, that the things which the Gentiles sacrifice, they sacrifice to devils, and not to God: and I would not that ye should have fellowship with devils.**

**1Co 10:21 Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils: ye cannot be partakers of the Lord's table, and of the table of devils.**

**2Jo 1:10 If there come any unto you, and bring not this doctrine, receive him not into your house, neither bid him God speed: (11) For he that biddeth him God speed is partaker of his evil deeds.**

**Rom 6:21 What fruit had ye then in those things whereof ye are now ashamed? for the end of those things is death.**

**There are many more verses, but you get the picture. There is nothing "Christian" about halloween. An internet search on the subject proves very interesting.**
