free to home users. It really works great. It asks me if I want to allow something to come into my computer every time before it allows it. It also asks me if I want to allow something to be sent from my computer every time something is about to be sent as well. But the nice thing is that it allows me to check the check box to remember something like my EUDURO Email program sending out an email or my Norton Anti-virus live update. So once I have told it that those are OK, it remembers that outgoing or incoming action and does not ask me again. I can recommend it to you highly. It works very well.

Dear Cordell Vail,

Thank you for your recent email to Susan Brown regarding the Utah Bus and cars running on hydrogen. She has asked me to respond.

While I have been working in the area of hydrogen fuel and fuel cell vehicles for much of the last five years, I am not familiar with Roger Billings or the Utah project. Thanks for bringing this interesting project to our attention.

The State of California, as may know, is very interested in hydrogen as a viable long term choice for transportation. In fact, a new web site was created (www.hydrogenhighway.ca.gov) on the idea to promote the development of a hydrogen fueling network in the state. While I am sure Professor Billings has rich experience in the area, several major automakers and other researchers have continued to advance hydrogen internal combustion vehicles and fuel cell vehicles operating on the fuel. BMW and Ford in particular have created impressive vehicles that operate on hydrogen. Furthermore, eight major auto companies are part of the Calif. Fuel Cell Partnership (www.cafcp.org).
