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## Consumer Tips

page and look at the picture of Horse Shoe Lake Park. I went there yesterday for my 3 month checkup AND THERE WAS NOT ONE MOLE HOLE IN THE ENTIRE PARK. There were 100's when I started a year ago. Now let them laugh.

Also if they are really persistent you can put moth balls in the Mole hole tunnel. It wont kill them. They just don't like the smell and will go elsewhere. But be very careful using moth balls. If a pet eats one it will destroy it's liver. If you chose to use this method (as a last resort), be sure to put the moth ball way deep into the mole tunnel and then cover the tunnel back up really good with dirt.

I have buried moth balls in the dirt around the base of my fruit trees in the spring for years to kill Peach Bore. That works really good too.
