4. Lettuce really love one another

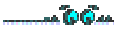
NO GARDEN IS WITHOUT TURNIPS:

Consumer Tips

How to prevent string from tangling: Roll the string into a ball. Then find an ordinary plastic funnel that is big enough to hold the ball of string. Nail the funnel to the wall or fix it on a bracket at a convenient height. Thread the loose end of the string through the funnel and let the ball of string rest in the funnel mouth. Now when you need some string just pull on the loose end protruding through the funnel end and you have untangled string feeding out.
